As the largest hunger relief charity in Queensland, your support will help to ensure that no Queenslander goes hungry.

We believe every Queenslander deserves to have access to food all year round. However, every single day, Queenslanders are going hungry. With the cost of living pressures impacting so many people in our community, families are being forced to choose between keeping a roof over their heads, paying essential bills, and putting food on the table. No matter who we are or where we come from, sometimes life gets tough.

That's why we are working with hundreds of frontline charities across Queensland to get fresh food to more than 150,000 Queenslanders in need each week.

Foodbank Queensland doesn't just give people food, we give them dignity and respect by providing a basic human right. But we can't do it without you.

Unfortunately, demand for food relief far outweighs supply – which is why your support is so important. For every dollar donated, you can provide two meals to somebody in need. Tackling food insecurity here in Queensland is a massive team effort and we're incredibly grateful to have your support!

6 simple steps to fundraise

It is really easy to set up a community fundraising project. Follow these 6 steps and you will be on your way to helping Queenslanders in need.

Choose your fundraising style

By hosting an afternoon tea or BBQ, giving up something (food, hair, phone), physically challenging yourself, having a dress up day or celebrate an occassion.

2 Setting a target

How many dollars would you like to raise?

Remember if you are close or have reached your target – increase it! People may be less likely to give if they think you are near your target so increase it and raise more! Also, it's a good idea to share how donations will help, for example you can let them know that a \$100 donation will provide 200 meals to Queenslanders in need or enables Foodbank to purchase over \$500 retail value of food.

3 Set up a fundraising page

You can fundraise for Foodbank Queensland on our dedicated fundraising website <u>fundraising.foodbankqld.org.au</u> or Facebook.

Post about it on social

Make sure you share your fundraiser with family, friends, and colleagues across all your social channels. And don't be afraid to ask people more than once if they haven't donated – post as much as possible, even after your event, to encourage as many donations as possible! 5 Thank your donors

It is very important to make sure you personally thank all your supporters and share the impact that they have made.

6 Bank your fundraising dollars

Setting up your fundraising page

Setting up a donation page online is simple and gives you flexibility with your fundraising.

A fundraising page can be personalised with photos, updates on progress, and thank you's to your supporters. Once your page is created, you simply send the link to your friends and family all over the world and they will be able to contribute to your fundraising efforts. It's easy for them to make a donation and your supporters will also receive a tax deducible receipt automatically.

Foodbank logo

A 'proudly supporting Foodbank' logo can be supplied for use on materials promoting your event. Prior to printing or distributing all promotional materials displaying the logo must be approved by Foodbank Queensland. Please email your materials to fundraising@foodbankqld.org.au and approval will be granted within 3 working days.

Media

Please send any media releases to Foodbank Queensland for approval prior to distributing, and our marketing team may be able to offer assistance or advice. You are most welcome to speak about your fundraising activity and why you are supporting Foodbank however, you are not authorised to speak on behalf of Foodbank Queensland.

Event name

It is wonderful to include Foodbank in your event's name, however it is important to follow the below format which makes it clear you are running the event and not Foodbank Queensland:
